Board Meeting Notes:

The Southland Car Club Board met on 12/28/23 from 7pm to 9pm at the Servidio residence. The following members were in attendance: Tony Losada, Andre Servidio, Janet Servidio, Louis Laporte, Mike Ventura, Dave Allen, and Paul Fowler.

The following items were discussed—

Member Dues – The dues for a new member will be \$25 which will cover the cost of the t-shirt and name tag. They can opt to add a significant other for an additional \$20 for an additional t-shirt and nametag. Annual dues will remain at \$15 per member and they are due in January. Those members that do not pay by the February meeting will become inactive members. Louis is updating the registration form to reflect these changes,

Committees – There are several committees that are not very active. Some of these function could be best served by the Board. These include: Membership, Property Management, and Sponsorship. Our Publicity/Social Media committee will need to be confirmed. This committee would control the Facebook page and the website. Additionally, they would track the sick and needy. The Scholarship committee only has one current member, Sherry Morales. It was decided that their should be at least three members to decide who receives scholarship monies.

Budget – There were many budget questions. Unfortunately, Dave Wiley had a conflict and was not able to attend this meeting. Some of the concerns are;

- Where are bank statements and where are they sent?
- Updating signature authority on our account.
- Standardizing the monthly financial reports.
- Recurring expenses – Liability Insurance, Trailer Registration, Banking fees, PO Box, Phone Tree, T-Shirts & Nametags, Equipment Maintenance, Club Supplies (50/50 tickets, Business cards, etc.), and Contingency Funds.
- Tracking paid annual dues.

Constitution and By-Laws – There are several changes that will be made to the Constitution and By-Laws. Several changes were approved, however, we were amending copies revised August 2017. David Allen states that there is a version from 2020. He will locate a copy and we will reassess the changes needed once we have that copy.

2024 Show – Board Members will meet with Deacon Jones to discuss the use of their location for our annual show. We are still planning on the October 2024 timeframe.

The Board has decided they will meet monthly for the first few months to make sure we kickoff 2024 on a positive note. Our next meeting is TBD.
